Packed curriculum for the education team

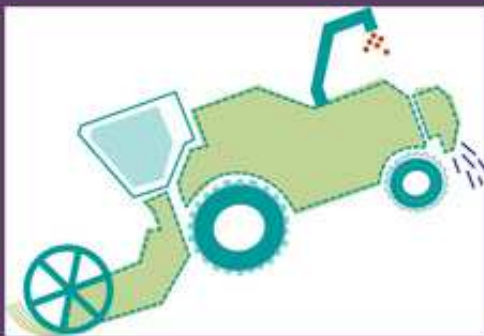
Combinable crops is the theme for this year's Farming School of the Year competition.
